Did You Know?

- Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent. It occurs forty days before Easter and can be as early as Feb. 4 or as late as Mar. 11, depending on the date of Easter (Apr. 12 this year).
- Ash Wednesday is traditionally observed by western Christians. Ashes of repentance are placed on the foreheads or hands of participants, along with the words “Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.”
- Some churches prepare the ashes by burning palm leaves from the previous year’s Palm Sunday celebration.
